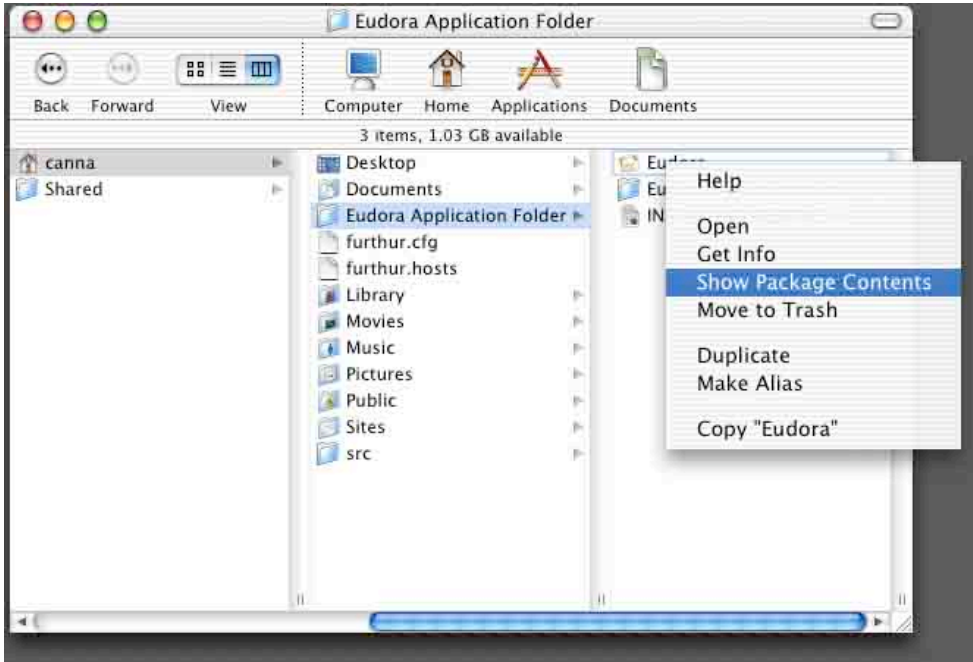
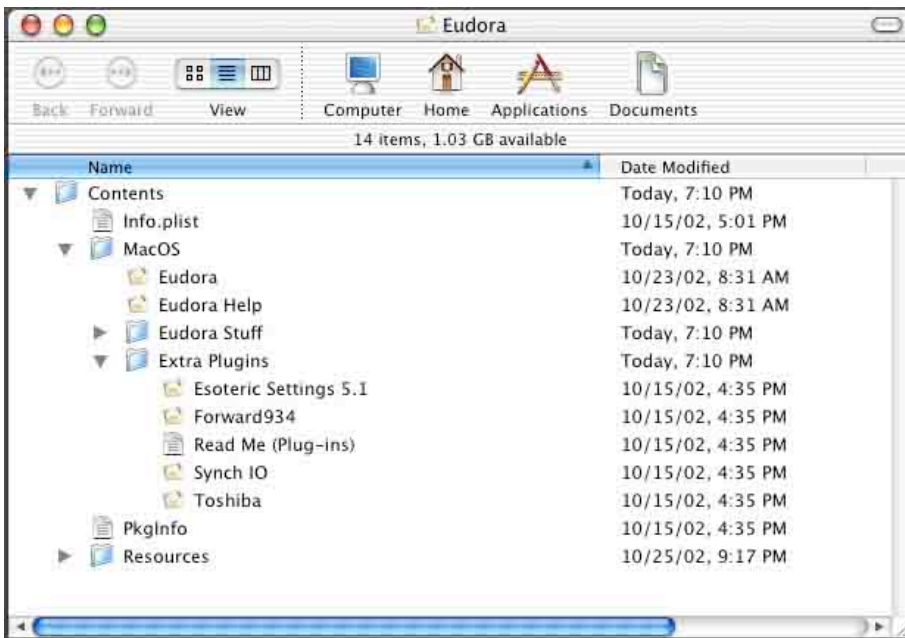


Configuring Eudora 5.2b14 on MacOS X to use the University of Michigan's Online Directory

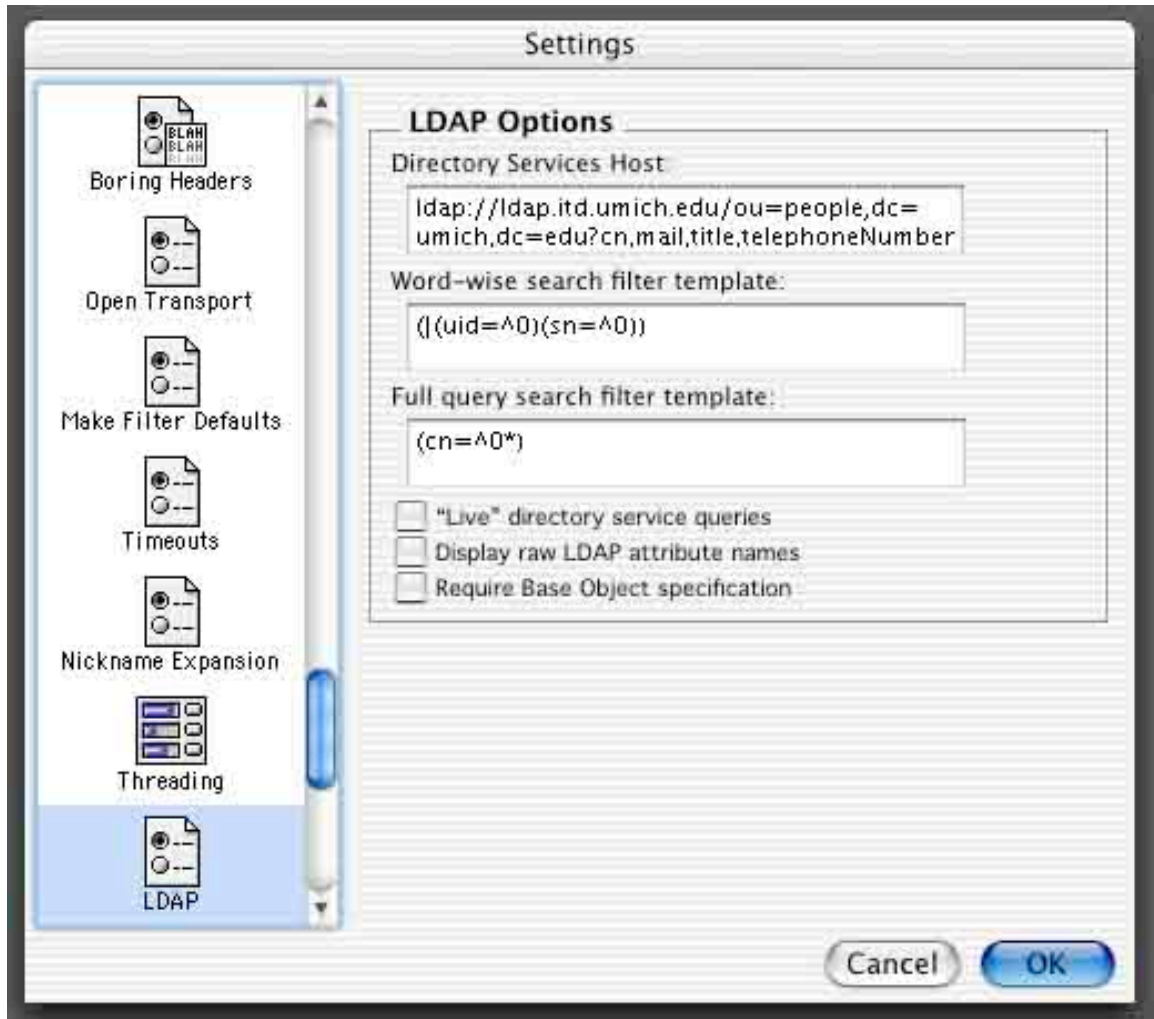
- 1) Locate the Eudora application
- 2) Control-click on the application, to bring up the menu below



- 3) Navigate through Contents:MacOS:Extra Plugins
- 4) Drag "Esoteric Settings" from "Extra Plugins" and drop it into "Eudora Stuff"



- 5) Launch Eudora
- 6) Go to the “Eudora” menu item (to the right of the Apple icon) and choose “Preferences”
- 7) Scroll through preference categories on the left until you find “LDAP”



- 8) Enter the lines listed in the fields above exactly as they appear.
 - a. **Directory Services Host**
ldap://ldap.itd.umich.edu/ou=people,dc=umich,dc=edu?cn,mail,title,telephoneNumber
 - b. **Word-wise search filter template**
(|(uid=^0)(sn=^0))
 - c. **Full query search filter template**
(cn=^0*)
- 9) Click “OK”.

- 10) To test out your settings, go to the menu bar and under the "Windows" menu, choose "Directory Services".
- 11) Type in a username or full name of the person you are looking for and watch the magic appear before your eyes!
